Looking for Volunteers

In celebration of Public Power Week, the City of Escanaba Electric Department is looking for volunteers to participate in an Energy Conservation Program. As part of the program, the City of Escanaba will select 25 single family residences and retrofit the lighting fixtures with energy saving CFL (Compact Fluorescent Light) bulbs, a new programmable thermostat and energy saving L.E.D. night lights. Once the energy savings devices are installed, the Electric Department will monitor the energy usage and savings for the previous 12 months and the next 12 months. It is important to note that there is no cost to the homeowner for participating in this program, and all names will be kept confidential.
