



NORTH SHORE FISH CLEANING STATION

Constructed in September of 2007, this unit is a state-of-the-art fish cleaning station and is the cleanest, safest, and most efficient method for cleaning fish and disposing of the waste. This unit is manufactured of stainless steel with poly cutting boards and equipped with a heavy duty disposal. For your safety and security, the North Shore complex is under 24-hour video surveillance monitored by the Escanaba Public Safety Department. Maintenance of this unit is performed by City of Escanaba employees to include cleaning and sanitizing on a daily basis. The public is welcome to use this unit free of charge.
