You will receive a response usually within one business day. On the rare occasion we are out of the office, we will get back to you the following business day. If you do not hear a response within several business days, follow-up with a phone call to our office.

The Assistant Assessor or the Assessor are available to meet during business hours M-F 7:30–4:00 EST, no appointment is necessary. To guarantee availability, you may make an appointment by call or email.

If you feel that you need your property inspected, you may call or email at any time to set up an appropriate time for the inspection. If you would like to see records maintained about your parcel, you may stop down to the office or submit your request via phone or email.

The Assessor is willing to see taxpayers and discuss any issues relating to their property values or classification at any time before the March Board of Review to try to resolve any issues there may be. Questions or discrepancies are typically resolved with an assessor review. You may stop in, call, or email our office to learn more about this process.

During annual field work, and the months of October to December, the Assistant Assessor will make a personal property canvass and report back to the Assessor. This canvass involves an observation of commercial districts, as well as a desk review of personal property parcels.
