



PUBLIC NOTICE

The City of Escanaba's Community Preservation Department will be monitoring properties for violations such as grass, weeds, garbage and debris which are not being maintained within the city limits of Escanaba. Failure to cut, remove, or properly maintain property areas will result in contractors being called to perform such maintenance. Citations and fines will also be issued in cases of habitual offenses.

The code Official will also be concentrating on motor vehicles which are in violation of the City's "Property Maintenance Code" PM. 303.8 Motor Vehicles. Unlicensed/uninsured vehicles or vehicles lacking vital component parts or that are mechanically defective as to be unsafe for operation shall be required to be removed from the City limits or properly stored within an enclosed building. Vehicles in violation of such ordinance will be impounded.

Residents are also reminded that permits are required before buildings, structures, fences, or signs are built or installed. Buildings or structures that are to be demolished within the properties of the City of Escanaba require a demolition permit.
