

LUDINGTON PARK



Escanaba's Ludington Park is 120 acres open from 7:30 a.m. to 11:00 p.m. daily. The park is a wonderful location for picnicking and offers a children's playground, Kiwanis music equipment, four multi-use lighted courts for pickleball and tennis with adjustable nets, one basketball court, 9 basket disc golf (check out discs at the Catherine Bonifas Civic Center and no cost), two sand volleyball courts, Karas Bandshell, Gazebo, Pavilion an informal baseball and soccer field, plenty of open green space, two expression swings, several swings, grills, water fountains, picnic tables and trail groomed for cross country skiing. Public restrooms are located within the park. The marina, Aronson Island boat launch, walking paths and Municipal Beach are also located within the park.

The historic lighthouse, Delta County Historical Society's Dr. John and Mary Beaumier Museum and Municipal Dock are also located nearby.

Dogs must be on a leash and doggy bags are located at the Municipal Dock, 4th Street near Lake Shore Drive intersection and Karas Bandshell.
